DEMO DERBY RULES AND REGULATIONS

All drivers are required to report to Fair Official at time of arrival. Cars and drivers are required to arrive at least 2 hours before start of event.

One entry per class.

No Coolers Or Glass in Pit Area.

Registration and Inspection to be completed by 6:30 pm. All cars Must be inspected by a Fair Board Official prior to start of event. All drivers Must attend the drivers meeting.

All drivers must be 16 years of age or older. Drivers under the age of 18 will require a parent's permission to be signed that day. The fair Board reserves the right to refuse any entry to any person and reject any entry.

**** Drivers are responsible for ensuring that anyone around their car has signed the insurance waiver. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.**

Disqualification for Any reason Will Not result in a refund. Judges decisions are Final. There is No gate refund to driver or pit crew.

The Fair Board has a **Zero tolerance policy for the consumption or possession of Any Alcohol or Controlled Substance by the driver or pit crew. Any person found in possession or under the influence will be disqualified.**

No hitting on the driver's door.

Only one tow vehicle per demolition vehicle in pit area.

Type of Car:

Any 1980+ North American made hard top sedan or wagon. No convertibles, jeeps, limos, checker cabs or trucks in the 8 cylinder class.

4/6 cylinder class may use small wagons or imports.

All cars must have approved working seat belts. All cars must have working CSA approved fire extinguisher secured within reach of the driver.

Drivers must have a CAS approved helmet with working chin straps. Eye protection Must be worn. No shorts. Drivers must wear long sleeves and gloves and should wear safety footwear - No running shoes.

One minute rule - No Playing Possum, No Sand Bagging.

Running and Safety Rules Will be Explained in MANDATORY DRIVERS MEETING.

The Word of any Event Official is Final.

Demolition Derby Preparation and Competition:

All work must be done prior to event. All extra parts and vehicles Must be removed from the site by 11pm after which they become the property of the Lombardy Agricultural Society.

All front doors Must be painted white, the numbers will be assigned and supplied by the officials of Lombardy Agricultural Society.

All flammable materials except the dashboard and driver's seat Must be removed.

All lights, trailer hitches, chrome moldings and exterior trim must be removed.

All windows and mirrors (All Glass) must be removed - the debris swept clean Before arrival.

All fuel lines Must Have a leak proof fitting with steel or rubber line No Exceptions.

Radiator must be in stock position and filled with water Not antifreeze.

Stock gas tanks Must be removed. Acceptable substitutes are CSA marine gas tank or custom metal tank, mounted in middle of back seat. No plastic Jerry cans allowed. After inspection tanks should be covered with a fire proof shield.

Cars with electric fuel pumps Must have a safety disconnect for fuel, located on right of steering wheel for easy access by Fair or Fire Official.

Battery Must be moved from stock position to the front passenger floor, contained in a box and a secure fireproof shield should be placed over it after inspection. (Only on 12 volt car battery).

Any Opening in the Engine Compartment Must be Covered by Maximum 1" Square Steel Mesh. Hood Must be fastened down in at least 4 places by wire strapping, chain or bolts. NO Welds.

NO Welding of frames except to secure bumpers. Over repaired frames will be considered reinforced and will result in disqualification. Any repaired frames

Must be revealed to the Fair Official at time of inspection. If any other welding is found it Will result in disqualification.

Only car bumpers may be used and Must remain front on front and rear on rear. Bumper shocks and brackets may be welded. End may be cut off. No truck or reinforced bumpers. No welding of bars to any inside of car or firewall.

Driver's door window cannot be covered with bars or screens. Drivers side windshield Must be covered with screen for safety. All air bags and sensors must be removed. In All Classes center bar Must be installed Vertically in center of

A crossbar May be added inside the car, door post to door post, behind the seat for safety from side crashes and to keep the seat from falling back.

All ball joints, tie rods, control arms and steering linkage must remain stock.

Rims Must be stock with No Welding.

Tires must be P-rated summer or all season tread. No Truck Tires, No Snow Tires, No Lug Tires, No Studs, No Screwing Tires to Rims. All wheel weight, trim rings and hubcaps Must be removed.

Doors and trunks Must be chain trapped or welded shut. No solid welds. Trunks will be inspected. All tech forms to be completed on site the day of event by checking off each item.
